From June 3 to June 28, 2019, registration will be open to fill vacancies for the Masters, Doctorate and Post-doctorate courses (admission in the 2nd semester of 2019), along with the Florida Graduate Program Assembly of God University - maintained by ITS- Institute Theology Science Florida USA - INC.

Entry into this Graduate Program is regulated by the ITS-USA Graduate Regulations and the Program Regulations.

## REGISTRATION

- Registration period: June 3 to June 28, 2019.
- When registering, the candidate may nominate up to 2 (two) teachers for his orientation, according to the list of supervisors (included in this Notice) of the Program that made vacancies available.
- Registration will be digital. No face-to-face registrations or registrations will be accepted outside the established deadline. In order to have his / her registration confirmed, the candidate must: a) complete the online registration form, which will be made available during the registration period at https://www.theologyscienceflorida.com/courses/; b) attach the requested documents (list of documents below) in a Portable Document Format PDF file. The registration form will be available from 9 am on June 1 until 6 pm on June 28, 2019.

o Identity card and CPF (neither the Professional Card nor the Driver's License will be accepted); the National Registry of Foreigners or the application protocol, in the case of foreign candidates;

If the documentation required for registration in the first phase is in disagreement with the notice, the registration will be canceled, without the right to refund the fee paid.

It will be held on July 7, 2019 (Sunday), from 2:00 pm to 6:00 pm in the Auditorium of the J. W. B. Costa Teaching Association - Votuporanga / SP.

- 1. On the day of the test, a theme defined by the Program Coordination will be made known on which the candidates must lecture, working with the suggested bibliography and discography.
- 2. The written test aims to assess the candidate's ability to write, conceptual articulate and interpret. This is not a proof of learning about the suggested bibliography and discography, but rather to mobilize them to address the proposed theme. The candidate can mobilize other texts that he deems pertinent, including his references at the end of his dissertation.
- 3. The suggested bibliography is divided between some book titles, book chapters and articles. There is also a suggested discography. Here is the list:

The duration of the test will be 4 (four) hours. In the initial sixty minutes, it will be allowed to consult only books and articles with ISSN. It should be noted that it will not be allowed to consult manuscripts or the use of electronic devices.

The tests will receive a score from 0 (zero) to 10 (ten). To be approved, the candidate must reach a minimum score of 7.0 (seven) points.

The test is valid for 2 (two) years.

## B. Proof of foreign language proficiency

Applicants must demonstrate proficiency in one of the following foreign languages: English.

The candidate can take the foreign language proficiency exam (and also in Portuguese, in the case of foreign applicants) directly in the AVA system - ITS-USA virtual learning environment, after the 1st phase (approved) https://moodle.theologyscienceflorida.com/.

To be approved, the candidate must obtain a sufficient grade (equivalent to grade 7.0 - seven). The result obtained will be valid for 3 (three) years. The candidate who has already taken the proficiency test for this Graduate Program in the last 3 (three) years, with approval, must inform in the registration form so that the use of the same is considered.

Other accepted certificates: the following certificates are also accepted (in accordance with the validity granted by the issuing institution), with the following scores: German Goethe-Zertifikat B2, minimum score: approved (test information: Goethe Institute www.goethe.de/br/sap/ptindex.htm); Spanish: DELE (Diploma de Español como Lengua Extranjera) - Intermediate level, minimum score: approved (information about the test: Instituto Cervantes, http://saopaulo.cervantes.es); French: DELF B2 (Diplôme d'Études en Langue Française B2), minimum score: approved (test information: Aliança www.aliancafranicando.com.br); French proficiency exam, minimum score: 70 points (test information: Aliança Francesa, www.aliancafranicando.com.br); English: TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language), minimum score: 550 points for the Paper Based Test - PBT and 79-80 points for the Internet Based Test - IBT (information about the test: www.ets.org/toefl ); IELTS (International English Language Testing System), minimum score: 5.5 points (information about the test: British Brazilian Council, www.britishcouncil.org/br/brasil.htm); FCE (The Cambridge Exams - First Certificate in English); Grade C or 60 points or higher (or equivalent - for example: Proficiency). Italian: CILS Dois - B2 (Certificazione di Italiano ea Lingua Straniera - Level B2), minimum score: approved (information on the test: Italian Institute of Culture of São Paulo, www.iicsanpaolo.esteri.it/IIC\_Sanpaolo).

For foreign candidates, in addition to proficiency in one of the languages mentioned above, proficiency in Portuguese is also required.

The Candidate must deliver to the ITS-USA Graduate Program, until July 18, 2019, a certified copy or simple copy, upon presentation of the original, the Certificate of Proficiency in a Foreign Language and a certified copy or simple copy, upon presentation of the original, of the Certificate of Proficiency in Portuguese for foreigners. Failing this provision, the candidate will not participate in the 2nd PHASE of the Selection Process and will be eliminated from it.

the Research Project printed in 1 copy and a PDF version recorded on CD, according to the following guidelines:

#### **Guidelines for the preparation of the project:** the project must include the following items:

- 1. Title:
- 2. Project summary;
- 3. Introduction / contextualization of the research theme;
- 4. Objectives / justification;
- 5. Theoretical / methodological bases;
- 6. Schedule;
- 7. Bibliography.

The project must have, excluding the bibliography, a maximum of 30,000 characters with space (including footnotes). The evaluation of the project will take into account, in addition to its general quality: a) the pertinence in relation to the Research Line of the chosen Program; b) their suitability to carry out a master's degree within a maximum period of 28 months;

c) the interdisciplinary potential of the research to be developed. At the end of the process, projects will receive a score from 0 (zero) to 10 (ten).

Candidates have the option of sending the required documentation for the 2nd phase of the selection process by mail. The documentation must be sent to:

Correspondence must be posted by July 20, 2019. Documentations whose posting date is later than the mentioned date will not be accepted. It is recommended that correspondence be sent in the form of Sedex with acknowledgment of receipt.

It is the sole responsibility of the candidate to send or deliver documents to the ITS-USA Graduate Program for participation in the 2nd phase of the selection process. If the documentation is in

disagreement with the notice or incomplete, the candidate will not participate in the argument of the research project (2nd Phase) and will be eliminated in the Selection Process.

#### • Evaluation and analysis of the research project and the candidate

It consists of an evaluation and analysis of the research project on the candidate's trajectory. The evaluation and analysis session will be held by a panel composed of 3 (three) teachers from the Program.

#### RESULTS

- **Result of the 1st phase** the list of those who passed the written test (eliminatory) will be available from July 21, 2019 on the website https://www.theologyscienceflorida.com/. The student who has reached the minimum grade 7.0 (seven) will be considered approved.
- **Appeals:** Failed candidates may appeal on the 24th and 25th of July 2019, (Wednesday and Thursday). The duly prepared resource must be delivered directly to the Graduate Program of ITS-USA. Appeals by e-mail will not be accepted. The results of the appeal requests will be announced on July 12, 2019 at https://www.theologyscienceflorida.com/.
- **Result of the 2nd phase** the list of those approved in the evaluation of the research project will be available from July 26, 2019 on the website https://www.theologyscienceflorida.com/. The student who has reached the minimum grade 7.0 (seven) will be considered approved.
- **Appeals:** Failed candidates will be able to appeal on July 27, 2019, (Tuesday) the appeal duly filled in with their own hand must be delivered directly to the ITS-USA Graduate Office. Appeals by e-mail will not be accepted. The result of the appeal will be announced on July 28, 2019 at https://www.theologyscienceflorida.com/.
- Final result The selection of those approved for entry to the program will be done by classifying the highest arithmetic averages of the marks obtained in the eliminatory test (1st phase) and in the research project question (2nd phase), in the available positions of the indicated advisors. In the event of a tie, the undergraduate school record will be taken into account.
